Later, he worked for 10 years as Professor at the National Institute of Health and Family Welfare, New Delhi, where he was also the Dean.

He has an MPH degree from the University of San Carlos, Guatemala, Central America. He has been a Fellow of the United Nations University.

He was the recipient of the National Citizen Award, 1992.

He is a Fellow of the National Foundation of Clinical Forensic Medicine.

He completed his LL.B from Delhi University and LL.M. from Kurukshetra University.

He joined the Bar in 2001.

He is a practising advocate in Health and medical law as the area of special interest.

He is a member of the Supreme Court Bar Association and Indian Law Institute.

He takes up cases for both Patients and doctors and has been engaged for his legal expertise by several IMAs And other associations of doctors.

He argues cases frequently in NCDRC.

He has also filed and argued writ petitions and has appeared before the M C I, various State Medical Councils, & before the PNDT authorities.
